Position Description

Reporting to the Stage Manager, the Venue Technician will ensure proper installation and running of lighting and audio visual equipment at the Aboriginal Pavilion key performance area under the direction and instructions of the principal sound and light designers. This position will work with internal and external client groups, including working with Partners on Theme Day presentations. These positions will be part of a team delivering a well hosted, world class visitor experience.

This is an evolving position and responsibilities may shift over time. Titles may be adjusted from time to time to accurately reflect responsibilities.

Responsibilities:

- Coordinate, manage, and control theatrical sound and lighting systems of the Aboriginal Pavilion and Showcase
- Liaise with production team to ensure events are of a world class calibre
- Install, test, and ensure running order of all audio visual systems at the Aboriginal Pavilion and Showcase
- Support Theme Day partners with technology and technical operations
- Support Signature Show with technical operations
- Support Evening programming with technical operations
- Report to the Stage Manager any deficiencies or items requiring follow-up
- Attend team and Pavilion meetings as required

Position Requirements

Education/Experience

- Three to five years of related experience
- Experience (and certification, where required) in setting up, adjusting, and taking down lighting and audio visual equipment
- Ability to communicate and negotiate with internal and external production companies and their employees
- Evidence of being proactive in production set up
- Previous experience with Aboriginal production an asset
- Previous experience with Aboriginal performance(s) preferred
- Evening and weekend work scheduling required
