The Métis Nation British Columbia has some **Olympic Tickets for sale at cost.**

The tickets include cost of local public transit "sky train and regular public bus" on the day of the event for which the tickets are issued. All mountain venue sports events require a separate and additional purchase of an Olympic Bus Network Ticket.

The sale of these tickets will be based on the following guidelines for name entry of a *'luck of the draw'* which will occur this Wednesday on the Métis Matters Radio Show 102.7 at 5pm to 6pm.

OPTION #1 - Youth 18 to 30 years of age: *Active community association involvement in events and activities.*

OPTION #2 - Families: *Active in Métis Family Events and or Activities relating to health at chartered community level*

OPTION #3 - Elders: *Volunteer sharing of Knowledge or information at a community event, active in association involvement in Métis communities*

OPTION #4 - Veterans: *need only to provide proof of Honorable service and be active within the MNBC community charter activities*

Each of the above **OPTIONS (1 to 4)** is independent, and one entry per person will be allowed to be entered into the *'luck of the draw'* for the opportunity to purchase tickets.

Tickets will be sold to Métis citizens who are confirmed through MNBC
