

The Aboriginal Youth Sport Legacy Fund (AYSLF) was created as an agreement between the Province of British Columbia, Squamish Nation and Lil'wat Nation, and the Vancouver 2010 Bid Corporation. Squamish and Lil'wat Nation and the Province of British Columbia appointed the 2010 Legacies Now Society trustee for the Aboriginal Youth Sport Legacy Fund.

Community Grants

Grants of \$1,000 will be awarded to Aboriginal communities based on need. The goal of these grants is to increase the capacity of the individual Aboriginal communities and organizations to offer sport or physical activity opportunities to youth. A maximum of one grant will be awarded to each organization.

Eligibility

- Aboriginal Band or community organizations;
- any Aboriginal sport and/or recreation organization;
- any non-profit organization that runs recreation, cultural and/or sport programs for Aboriginal youth;
- organizations must operate out of British Columbia and directly service Aboriginal youth within BC.
